Headteacher message –

Thank you to everyone who supported Comic Relief last Friday. We are delighted that we raised £128.09 via Parent Pay. It was wonderful to see costumes and fun activities in class, all for a great cause.

### **Change of times after Easter holiday**

After a review of parent dropping and collection times and our running arrangements, Illogan School will be reverting towards our usual hours from Monday 19th April. These changes will allow TA preparation time, maximise curriculum time in the afternoon and still allow for staggered access to the site.

Our gates will open at 8.40 am to allow children to enter the site and go straight to their classrooms. The bell will continue to ring at 8.50 when the gates will be locked again, registers taken and learning will begin.

In the afternoon, the gates will be opened at 3.00 and children should be collected by 3.10. All children with walking home permission will be dismissed at 3.10.

We hope you can support us with these small changes by only accessing the site if necessary and by retaining social distance at all times.

Our Breakfast Club continues to operate and there is a registration form attached if your child has not attended before. Drop off is in our front office and there is no need to book in advance. Payment is via Parent Pay.

Mrs Bright and I will continue to ensure that the car park is staffed before and after each school day so please do ask any questions you may have.

Other than these tweaks all of our other Covid Risk Assessments remain in place and we will continue to operate in strict bubbles with staff working in only one bubble. Above everything we will continue to prioritise the Health and Safety of everyone here. Cornwall Council have issued advisory emails this weekend stating that our R rate in Cornwall increased by 25% last week. Please do not let your guard down and ensure that you operate within Government guidance at all times. It is only by working together now that we will be able to relax our rules later in the year.
